Abstract: The maximum 300 words, typed in MS word (in windows XP) only results to be given. Keep specified margin- 3cm left hand margin, 1.5cm right hand and 2.5cm from top and bottom. The title of the paper should be in 14 point font and rest of the text in 12 point in NEW TIMES ROMAN. Single inter-line spacing is to be used for text portion. Submission of paper on given e-mail is preferred followed by a hard copy through Air mail /postal services to Prof.. Meena Patil , Chairman rtbb-2007, Dept. of Zoology, Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad-431004 Maharashtra, INDIA.

Preparation of full manuscript of papers to be published in proceeding

The page limit for invited papers is 8-10 pages including tables, photographs and text matter. The contributory papers shall be of 4-6 pages. However, Chairman and proceeding committee has full rights to curtail the unwanted or repeated matter, if there is any.

Abstract: A short abstract of 150-200 words, approximately.

Key words: 2-4

Introduction: 300 words

Material and Methods: possibly make short with important techniques.

Results and Discussion: The maximum two-three paragraphs with 500-600 words.

References: The single references in the text matter should be given with author name and year in the bracket. More than two references cited together have to mention in bracket ascending order of years. Sandeman (1990) or (Andrew et al 1978, Mirajkar)
